

	Entry to cohort area (only if necessary) no patient contact*	General ward	High risk unit ICU/ITU/HDU	Aerosol generating procedures (any setting)
Disposable Gloves	No	Yes	Yes	Yes
Disposable Plastic Apron	No	Yes	Yes	No
Disposable Gown	No	No	No	Yes
Fluid-resistant (Type IIR) surgical mask (FRSM)	Yes	Yes	No	No
Filtering face piece (class 3) (FFP3) respirator	No	No	Yes	Yes



This is undertaken outside the patient's room.


Pre-donning instructions

- ensure healthcare worker hydrated
- tie hair back
- remove jewellery
- · check PPE in the correct size is available

Perform hand hygiene before putting on PPE

Disinfection of a contaminated surface

- 1. I tablet of actichlor in 11 of water,
- 2. wash,
- 3. Wait for it to dry,
- 4. wash again with soapy water


